Flavour hop None

Aroma hop Bramling Cross

Dry hop vanilla extract!

Gen We took the "first runnings,, from our Marduk stout's mash and added double the hops to create a truly monstrous stout; thick, bitter, roasty and hoppy, it should be a proper Imperial Stout albeit one with a British hop character! Only 4.5 gallons were produced and 100ml of real vanilla extract added to the cask!
